Thank you also to Dr. Darren Berman, spearheading our new Development Committee to build resources that are the foundation of PICS educational programs.

Rapidly Expanding Membership: PICS has become the "must join" international membership society for your profession, serving as your collective voice where that voice needs to be heard. Next goal: increase public awareness of the amazing work you do and your dedication to patients and their families. Guidelines for indications for interventional treatment of CHD is nearing completion (also led by Dr. Holzer). Guidelines Committee Chair Dr. Athar Qureshi, Co-Chairs Drs. Tom Fagan and Chris Petit, and committee members Drs. Catherine Tomasulo and Varun Aggarwal are spearheading additional guidelines initiatives.

ACHD Interventional Treatment: Under Chair Dr. Jamil Aboulhosn, the ACHD Committee has an ambitious agenda of advocacy, education
